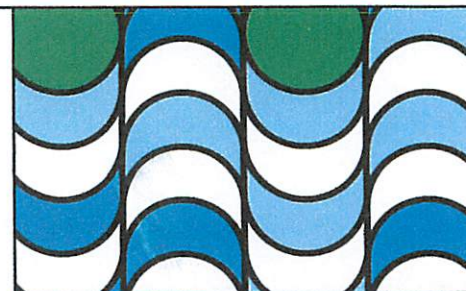

Membership in Chicago Sinai Congregation is your way of saying that our values and the programs that we offer are important to you and your family. We ask all members to contribute according to a dues schedule reflecting the financial resources of individuals and families at different stages of life.

Individual memberships are for single-person households only. Family memberships are available to both married and unmarried couples. All members who have children enrolled in the Religious School are expected to maintain a family membership.

Please consider Sustaining Membership as a way of helping Sinai increase the quality and quantity of its programs. Sustaining Members are those persons who elect to pay higher dues, in accordance with the above schedule. The names of all Sustaining Members are listed in the Temple Bulletin each year. Sustaining members also receive additional High Holy Days cards of admission.

The Congregation makes every effort to respond to the concerns of persons with special financial needs in formulating a level of support that is both comfortable and appropriate. Persons with special financial needs should contact the Executive Director for more information.

Our fiscal year is July 1 to June 30. One-half of your yearly dues must be paid before High Holy Day cards of admission are mailed. You may select one of three payment schedules to meet your needs:

- **A one time annual payment** due upon submission of the membership application and annually thereafter on July 10th.
- **Two equal payments.** The first payment is due upon submission of the membership application. Payments are due every July 10th and January 1 thereafter.
- **Four equal payments.** The first payment is due upon submission of the membership application. Payments are due each July 10th, September 1, January 1 and April 1 thereafter.
