Chicago Sinai Congregation observes this tradition by preparing an annual Book of Remembrance which is distributed during the Yizkor Services on Yom Kippur, Wednesday, October 9. We consider it equally appropriate to remember Jewish and non-Jewish departed loved ones at this season.

Memorial Plaques

To remember departed family and friends, memorial plaques, inscribed with the names of your loved ones, can be added to our Memorial Board during the High Holy Days if your order is received no later than August 26. A memorial plaque is \$1,000.
